IMPORTANT:

VicRoads requires you have sufficient identification before you can sit your Learner Permit Test. Vic Roads requires 3 pieces of ID one from each of the following categories:

1. Primary ID:

A full birth certificate, current passport or citizenship documents.

2. Secondary ID:

Medicare card, student card, bank/credit card, **telephone/gas/electricity bill**

3. Evidence of Victorian residency:

Bank statement, proof of age card, concession or health care card.
