INTRODUCTION

WHAT IS THE DIRECTORY?

The Central Highlands Local Health Services Directory has been developed to support the health needs of children and young people living in Out of Home Care. Access to timely and quality healthcare is essential to identify health concerns and optimise health outcomes. The purpose of this directory is to support access to appropriate and affordable health care and specialist services for all those involved in a child's care.

** This directory is a guide for those supporting children and young people in Out of Home Care and does not list every available service provider.*

Carers play a vital role in supporting the health needs of the children and young people in their care. Carers and case managers will work together to arrange health appointments and the necessary follow up. Carers will have certain responsibilities and requirements to address the health needs of the children in their care; case managers will be responsible for other tasks and referrals. The roles and responsibilities of all involved in the care of the young person will be clearly communicated.

MORE INFO

If you have a health issue or need a health check, the first person you usually go to see is a GP. It is recommended that you try to see the same GP each time if possible. This way you won't need to repeat your story and the GP will get to know your health needs.

Every child or young person entering Out of Home Care is required to see a GP for an Initial Health Assessment. A thorough health history will be taken, a physical assessment will occur and a management plan will be developed to ensure all outstanding and future health needs are addressed.

Having a Medicare number, and where possible a Medicare card, is important so you can access health care and medicines at low cost or no cost, as most of the cost is covered by the government.

This directory is also available via an App on your phone. Its available from the App Store and Google Play and is called Healthdirect.

- + Check with the GP practice before you go to see if they will bulk bill. This means that the GP charges Medicare only for the consultation and you will not need to pay anything.
- + You will need to make an appointment at most GP practices.
- + There are some walk in clinics where appointments are not needed. These are useful for injuries or urgent issues, however seeing the same GP is preferred wherever possible.
- + Request a long or double appointment if the child or young person is attending for their Initial Health Assessment. This allows time for the GP to complete a comprehensive review.
- + A carer may use their own family, or preferred, GP for the Initial Health Assessment and the ongoing treatment of the child or young person in their care.
- + Children and young people identifying as Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander may be eligible to access free or low cost medication under the Close the Gap initiative. Please discuss eligibility with your GP.

When you see the GP, they may recommend that you see another health professional to help with a particular health condition a child or young person may have. If needed, they will give you a referral to see a specialist, such as a paediatrician, or refer you to other health professionals, such as a speech therapist or psychologist. You can't see a specialist without having a referral from your GP first.



Many GP Clinics and other health service providers use a website and App called HotDoc for appointment bookings.

Head to www.hotdoc.com.au or download the HotDoc app to your device.

You can create a secure account that allows you to view available appointments and make bookings at a range of health clinics, using simple search functions.

MORE INFO

Maternal and Child Health (MCH) Services provide comprehensive health checks for children from 0 to school age.

MCH is a free primary health service available for all families with children from birth to school age, where families visit MCH nurses at ten key stages of the child's development.

MCH centres operate in local communities.

Some centres may be managed by local councils while others are managed by health services.

Centres are staffed by highly trained MCH nurses who:

- + do regular child health and development checks and screens
- + link families with other services and give information and tips on a range of parenting topics
- + help families who need higher levels of support within their home

Support may be provided in a variety of settings, including the family home, the MCH centre or other locations within the community.

Your GP may suggest treatment by an allied health practitioner such as a speech therapist, occupational therapist, a mental health worker or psychologist. Ask your GP to develop a Health Management Plan or Mental Health Care Plan so you can access subsidised care through Medicare.

EYES EARS AND TEETH

OPTOMETRIST: EYE CHECK



There are many optometrists in our region that do not charge a person for an eye check. They will charge Medicare directly (also known as bulk billing). You should call and ask them before you book an appointment.

There are a number of optometrists that provide services on behalf of the Australian College of Optometry (ACO) through the Victorian Eyecare Service (VES) and the Victorian Aboriginal Spectacles Subsidy Scheme (VASSS) which helps people to access low cost glasses. To be eligible, you need to have a pension or health care card or identify as an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person. You also need to have an eye check with an optometrist that is signed up to the VES in order to access low cost glasses. <https://www.aco.org.au/ves-directory/>

ACO has other programs that may assist if the costs of glasses are too much. Ask the optometrist to contact the ACO on 03 9349 7400 or email outreach@aco.org.au to see if you might qualify for further support.

AUDIOLOGIST: HEARING CHECK



Audiologists are the first step for hearing health care. They aim to prevent hearing loss. They can assess, diagnose and treat hearing disorders.

A referral from a GP (or another medical professional such as a paediatrician) is essential when accessing a low-cost hearing check with Ballarat Hearing Clinic. If a hearing check finds that the child has a hearing issue, they will refer you to Hearing Australia, who are the only providers of free hearing equipment and devices for people under 26 years old. To access this free program, you must have had a hearing check and a diagnosis of hearing loss.

You can receive a health check at Australia Hearing for an out of pocket cost of \$110, for children 3 years and over.

IMMUNISATION CHECK

It is important to ensure a child's immunisations are up to date so they can attend places such as long day care, occasional care, kindergarten and school.

For children from birth to school age, your local Maternal and Child Health Nurse can check a child's immunisation status on the Australian Immunisation Register and provide any immunisations to ensure a child is up to date with their immunisations.

For school age children, a GP can access statements on the Australian Immunisation Register to check on a child's immunisation history. Most GP practices have nurses that are available to provide immunisations to make sure a child has had all of their required immunisations.
